Staff Professional Development 2022 (PLD)

On Tuesday 1st February 2022, we welcome the SAF (Student Achievement Facilitators) from the Ministry of Education Tania Tawhi and Colleen MaGuniess who will be providing support to raise student achievement in both Rumaki and Auraki next year. Pukekohe North School is thriving to change the achievement gap in our students' learning and raise the level of achievement. We look forward to working with Tania and Colleen next year.

Raising Student Achievement - 90% minimum attendance rate

The school has an expectation that children must be at school everyday if we want to raise student achievement in 2022. The school's expectation is 90% minimum attendance. If you find meeting this standard a challenge next year, we are going to struggle to raise the achievement levels for our students who are absent frequently. We will review our process for managing absenteeism and advise our school community what will happen when our students are absent for more than 2 days.

Teacher Aide Employment Review Process

The employment review process reducing our teacher staff for 2022 is nearing an end. We have started interviewing our Teacher Aides today and tomorrow. Our teacher aides find out next Tuesday 14th December who is successful in obtaining employment next year. I would like to acknowledge those Teacher Aides who are being interviewed at this time for their understanding for participating in this arduous process.
