
FRIDAY 3RD SEPTEMBER

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
Tips for using Google Slides (1):

I. If you accidentally delete a slide, you can go to HERE.

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This will show you all the previous versions that were saved to your Google Drive. Select a version that will restore the file before deletion.

2. If you accidentally delete an object or text box, this can be fixed! Use the UNDO button located on the toolbar. You can click on this button as many times as needed to undo errors. The button is found HERE.


3. It is important to know how to zoom in and out. This can be done in a couple of different ways: b) Click on the ZOOM icon on the


click Zoom in or Zoom out...


a) Click on View and in the dropdown menu, click Zoom In. The Zoom Out option is located here also.

- Turn on Speaker Notes by selecting it from the ... menu in the top right corner.


Go to the next page for a Super hero Dad card. With both cards you could make your own or print the card out and write your own words on it.
