Choose one of your ideas and draw a picture of what it should look like.

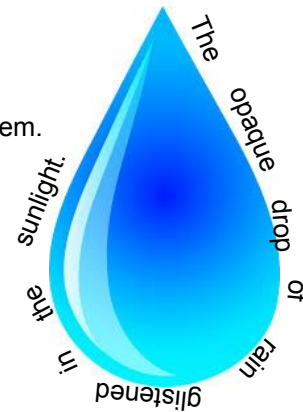


Writing: Shape Poem

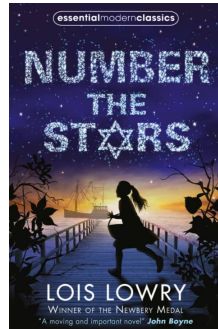
