



Lockdown Notice

Wednesday 23 February 2022

Kia Ora Whaanau,

Pukekohe North School went into Lock down from 11.20.a.m. until 12.15.p.m. today.

We were warned by local residents that there was unrest in the Frank Hewitt / Times Place area.

Our aakonga/students remained in class with doors and windows locked and carried on with their normal class work.

We understand that during the incident that Police were called and a stand-off occurred.

Police phoned the school at 12.15.p.m. to give us the all clear.

We waited a further 5 minutes and then opened up as usual and gave out the school lunches.

Our Year 7-8 students headed to Pukekohe Intermediate for their Technology sessions and the remainder of the school had lunch and finished their morning classes.

Everything was calm and in control.

Aakonga/students are returning to afternoon classes as I write this note to you.

Our gates will open again at 2.40.p.m. to send the tamariki home.
