Kia ora koutou,

Teachers are preparing lessons for the return to learning on Wednesday 15 April.

This looks very likely to be in the form of On Line Learning for each whanau.

I have asked our staff to make contact with each of you this week to seek how the Ministry of Education can provide a device and Internet Connections to those whanau who need it.

Staff will ask you the following questions:

1. What is your address? (So the Ministry can deliver a device directly to your door)
2. Do you have a device at home? (Laptop, I-pad, Chrome Book, Tablet?)
3. Do you have access to the Internet? (Who with- Vodafone, Spark, etc)
4. Do we have the correct phone numbers for your whanau?
5. What is the best way to make contact with you about your child(ren's) education? (Text, email, Zoom, phone call, FaceBook, School App?)

I need to inform the MOE with this data by 9.4.2020 so that they can get devices to you.

However, The Ministry of Education are clear that students sitting NCEA in 2020 are their FIRST Priority so whanau may need to wait for their device to arrive.

Staff will be planning your child's ongoing education over the next week.

Pukekohe North School will make contact with you regularly as we move towards the Term 2 commencement.
