Staff met for our Teacher Only Day this morning and to make preparations for the return to school for the children of Essential Workers.

We have 12 students registered to start school tomorrow Wednesday 29 April from 8.30.a.m.

A reminder of our organisations:

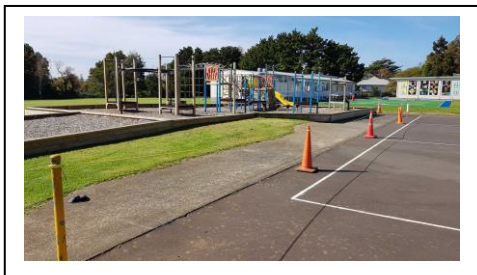
- Students enter and leave the school through our gates on Beatty Road Only.
- Students will meet in the hall to commence their days and be reminded of our COVID-19 Expectations



- Students will hand sanitise regularly during the day
- Surfaces will be disinfected at the end of each learning block
- We remind whanau that if a child has a runny nose, cough or sore throat we will send them home.
- Students are to bring a named water bottle and their food to school each day along with their pencil cases / devices



- Students MUST follow social distancing – 2 metres in the playground / 1 metre inside buildings
- Students have been organised to learning in Whanau Bubbles of up to 10 students
- Whanau Bubbles are not allowed to meet together and will have separate parts of the playground to play in
- Students are not allowed to play with sports equipment this week (we will review this by Friday)



- One group will work out of Room 12 and the other from Room 5.
- Students will continue to work through the learning activities organised by their classroom teachers.
- Teachers and Teacher Aides are rostered to supervise and assist the students during their school day.
- Students will be dismissed in their Whanau Bubbles and 5 minutes apart.
- Students are expected to go home immediately and not visit local playgrounds or friend's houses.
- Students would expect to be entering their properties by 2.45.p.m. daily

For children completing Home Learning:

- We have devices available for Year 5-8 students and hard copies of resources for Years 1-4
- These can be collected from the school office from 9.00.a.m. on Wed 29 / Thursday 30 April

- These numbers are manned from 9.00.a.m.- 2.30.p.m. Monday to Friday.
- We expect to be at Level 3 Lock Down for 2 weeks
