COVID Level 2 - Students Returning to Pukekohe North School.

This Safety Plan is set to protect our students, staff and community as we venture to a new kind of norm for Schooling post COVID 19 Lockdown:

ENTERING SCHOOL PREMISES:

1. Students are to bring the following in their school bags: jumpers, raincoats, named water bottle, food, pencil cases and device (if you have been given one from the MOE /School)
2. Lunches SHOULD be brought from home. We will HOWEVER accept lunch orders from the local dairy
3. Entry into school will be via the side gate on Beatty Road for students and the community from 8.20-9.00.a.m. and into the school hall.
4. After 9.00.a.m., entry into school will be through our main school administration area
5. Staff will triage students as they enter the hall for any cold like symptoms.
6. Any students who are symptomatic should have their temperatures checked at the school office. Whanau will be informed if temperatures are outside of the norm (36.1–37.8°C)
7. Visitors are banned from the site unless on official business
8. All visitors to our school will be contract traced through Registration at the School Hall / Admin Area
9. Everyone MUST hand sanitise as they leave the hall for the classrooms

BREAKFAST:

10. Breakfast is available in the x 4 teams - Junior, Middle, Senior and Kura Rumaki
11. Servers will wear gloves and masks when preparing the food

ENTERING CLASSROOMS:

12. Hand sanitizing will commence the day, follow all visits to the toilets, before eating AND on re-entering the classroom and after sneezing or coughing
13. Students are to sit an arm's span apart in classrooms
14. Classes will have an organised play time outside (weather permitting)
-See timetables below.
15. Work surfaces, door handles and toilets will be disinfected after each teaching block by staff
16. Should a child become ill or need medical attention, they will be isolated in the sickbay and whanau called immediately (Families MUST have organised someone who can collect sick children)
17. Students who are continuing their schooling from home during Alert Level 2 will be marked absent as 'E'
18. Teacher Aides will be employed from 8.20.a.m. - 1.50.p.m. to assist in classrooms
19. Teacher Aides will be allocated to each classroom until Friday 29 May. In Class Support students will be supported with their usual hour per day adult assistance. Those who are not physically attending can be supported by Zoom Hui (Technology Dependent)
20. Staff are charged with developing a 'new norm' for our students after 6 weeks lock down at home
21. Programmes are to cover the full curriculum and include x 3 break times during the day and Brain Breaks during Learning Blocks
22. Teachers will emphasize the Key Messages below. These will be made into Posters in English & Maori and used as daily teaching resources to remind students of our expectations
23. Staff are to emphasize PB4L Tier 1 Strategies

IN THE PLAYGROUND:

24. Students are allowed to use the Adventure Playgrounds and are allowed to have access to PE Equipment
25. The Adventure Playgrounds will be santised daily with a disinfectant solution
26. Water fountains are shut down until at least 29.5.2020

END OF THE DAY:

27. At the end of the school day, students will be sent home at spaced intervals
28. We will not hold any staff meetings during the first 2 weeks
29. School Assemblies are on hold until Friday 29 May 2020 (inclusive)
30. Kura Rumaki morning karakia will be held in the hall but following 1 metre social distancing rules
31. Team Meetings via Zoom are encouraged
32. Crest Clean to cover the ITC Suite
33. Staff will sanitise computer screens and keyboards

ORGANISATIONAL MATTERS:

34. The library will remain closed until Friday 29 May
35. KiwiCan will commence from Monday 25 May
36. Staff will be provided with: Water Bottles, Hand Sanitiser, Disinfectant Spray Bottles,Cloths

Key messages to our Students and Community:

(Until 29 May 2020)

Enter school through the Beatty Road Gate in the morning

Think about your Moist Breath Zone-Keep an arm's length away from others

Try not to touch your face and let viruses enter your body

Always sneeze into your elbow

If you have arunny nose, cough, sore throat or fever stay home

Sanitize your hands regularly but especially -

>On Entry into Classrooms

>After going to the toilet

>Before eating

>Dont share food or drinks - this might share viruses
