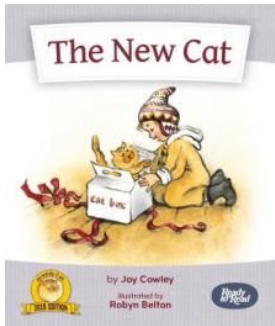

Tap on your book it will lead you to your link, scroll down to The New Cat book and tap **text** so you are able to read the book.

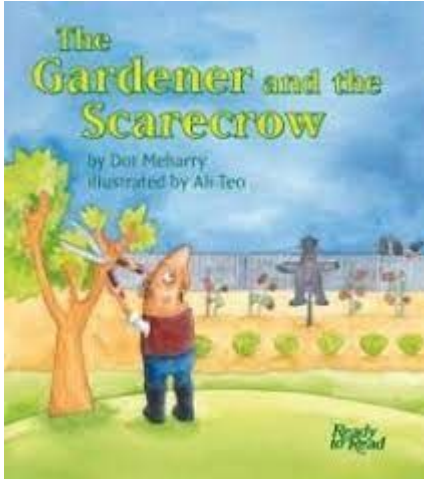
In a video I want you to retell the story in your own words and then submit to my email.

Success Criteria: When they see a ! they actually shout.



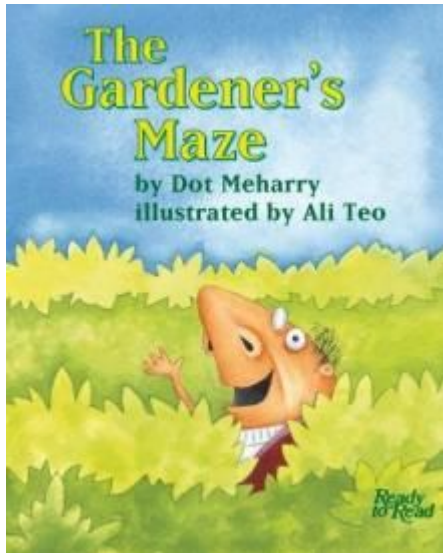

Ready to Read

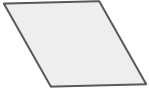
- Tap on the book, the link is a Youtube video I would like you to mute it, and read on your own.

Hundertwasser toilets in Kawakawa

Austrian architect and artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser moved to New Zealand in the 1970s and created his toilet masterpiece in 1999. But the architect never got to see how popular it would become in the next two decades as the following year he died at sea at the age of 71.



Using an eclectic assortment of materials, including bricks recycled from the recently demolished Bank of New Zealand building, tiles that were made for the purpose by students at Bay of Islands College, empty bottles, concrete, steel, copper and bits and pieces of ceramics from his own studio, the maestro constructed the new Kawakawa convenience around a tree.
