Here is a timetable suggestion for completing your work:

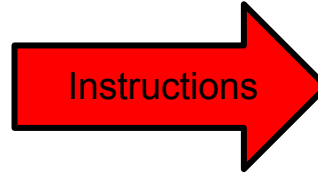

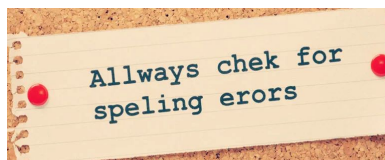

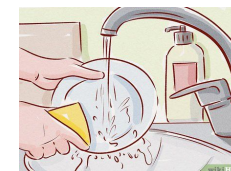
### Managing Self

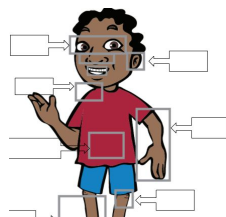
