Short fruit break/ Fitness	Try one of the bonus activities
Reading - Read one of the books plus a read along if wanted.	Games: Play a game with your family and have lots of fun. Eg eye spy, snakes and ladders, puzzle, lego,



- Mat, men, moon, dog, dot, deep, ant, and, am



























Phonics - cont













Practice sight words appropriate to your child's level if unsure contact your child's teacher.









































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







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


















































Writing - Draw a picture then write about it!

Help students to write some stories (about 2-4 sentences) once a day.

Help them sound out the words and remind them of the sight words that they know. Focus on a full stop at the end of an idea and a capital letter at the beginning.

Some ideas of things you can write about include:

- Make a poster about your family
- Draw a crab and label the parts of it's body
- Write a letter to your favourite cousin
- Make a list of all the shellfish you know
- Find out about crabs what do you know about them
- What kind of activities do people do at the beach?
- What would happen if you built a house on the beach
- Learn about a beach you have never been to.


