



History

Origins of the lantern festival:

From Asia New Zealand Foundation

The Lantern Festival has been part of the Chinese New Year celebrations since the Han Dynasty (206 BC – 221AD).

Usually held on the 15th day of the first month of the lunar calendar, it marks the end of New Year festivities.

The lanterns come in all shapes and sizes. Some are created in the form of animals, insects, flowers, people or even machines and buildings. Others depict scenes from popular stories teaching filial piety and traditional values. A favourite subject is the zodiac animal of the year.
