Whanau Hui:

The Board of Trustees organised for Representatives from the Ministry of Education to discuss Maori Medium Education and population trends in Franklin over the next 10 years last week at Pukekohe North School.

Their data points out that in excess of 5,200 students of Maori descent will move to our area by 2033.

Our education system needs to cater for these students moving forward especially as over a third of New Zealand Schools provide Te Reo Maori classes at this point and the need continues to climb.

We are hosting a meeting to be chaired by Rachael Tuwhangai and Mike King who are working for the Ministry of Education at present to plan a Maori Medium Education Pathway for Tāmaki Makaurau.

This hui will take place in the next 6-8 weeks.

In preparation for this hui, we are calling a whanau hui with these major points on the agenda:

- 1. Presenting the findings of the last whanau hui in our hall on Thursday 2 July. Staff have collated whanau responses from the questions posed at that hui.
- 2. What are the hopes and dreams of whanau in planning an educational pathway for our tamariki?
- 3. What delivery pathway would this plan follow?
- 4. What are the steps for the community moving forward to allow the above to become a reality?

This hui will take place in the school hall on Wednesday 19 August from 5.30-6.30.p.m.
