TUMUAKI TALKS

Kia Ora Whaanau,

Teacher across New Zealand will strike tomorrow, Thursday 16 March to protest the lack of movement in the claims addressed to the Ministry of Education regarding pay and working conditions.

Franklin Teachers and Principals are boarding a bus at New World to be transported to Fort Street in Auckland City and to march up Queen Street and assemble in Albert Park.

We are aware after a disrupted start to the school year, that this is disruptive to whaanau and aakonga. We are sorry for this but we need to make a strong statement to the Government that they must come back to the negotiation table with offers to address

- Unfortunately, the funding for our schools and kindergartens is not enough for us to give us the time we would like to support all our kids to thrive.
- We need to attract and retain educators by ensuring that teaching is a valued and attractive profession.
- Principals and teachers in primary and area schools and kindergartens have considered at length offers from the government to settle our respective collective agreements.
- The offers did not meet our expectations, nor make sufficient steps towards the changes we need for our children to succeed.

We will supervise aakonga at school if whaanau have no other alternatives to look after tamariki at home. (8.15,a.m.-2.40.p.m.

Pukekohe North School will re-open for instruction on Friday 17 March as normal.

CLASS PHOTOS


On Monday 27 March, we will be organising Class and Individual photographs for the tamariki.
