NEW DEVELOPMENTS & REPAIRS AT OUR SCHOOL

New Furniture:

The Board has used the holiday period to complete a variety of projects.

At the end of 2023, the Board organised to provide new class furniture in Rooms 1-2-8-9-10-11 and 12. During the year, Rooms 3-4-5-6 also received their classroom refurbishments and new furniture as well. The new furniture arrived last week and the kaiako have set up their classrooms for learning. ICT/ Music Suite Portico:

Whaanau might have noticed the ceiling of the entrance falling away.

The Board organised for the ICT Portico's roof, drainage, and ceiling to be repaired and painted and this was completed last Friday.

Grounds Work:

Rooms 1 and 2 have endured ponding outside of the classrooms during any heavy rain. A broken pipe outside of the library had to be dug up and replaced. This was also completed during the holidays.

Room 14 has always been shaded due to two large trees shadowing the classroom. The Board had these removed early in January and debris cleared from the large trees by the hall. This was potentially a hazard in high winds and we didn't want any accidents in winter.

We have plans to paint the school exterior in 2-3 years so to preserve the paint, each block and the rooves were water-blasted recently.
